Information requested

- 1. The amounts of funds received from funding sources (UK, Europe etc.), including breakdowns in the various Smart categories.
- 2. Details on grant amounts given (in full), grant amounts given (partials) and most importantly those funds not utilised (of the total received).

Our response

£12,560,568 has been received from the EU and £18,293,886 from the Welsh Government for the Smart RD&I grant schemes. There is no funding unallocated. The attached spreadsheet provides the breakdown as requested above.

The figures relate to the period 2014-2022. The operation closed to applications in February 2022. The amount awarded is currently greater than that paid as a number of projects are still being completed and the funding is yet to have been drawn down.

I have also attached a copy of our Quick Look Guide, that summarises how the support for each element is structured.
