- 1. The total adverse reactions and deaths in Wales for AstraZeneca, Moderna and Pfizer vaccines;*
- 2. The overall total of adverse reactions and deaths for all 3 vaccines in Wales.*

Our Response

The Welsh Government does not hold this information. As you are already aware, the data is collected and published by the Medicines and Healthcare Products Regulatory Agency (MHRA) on a UK wide basis.
