I wrote to you on 20 September regarding your request for information.

Your request

You have asked for the following information regarding public money administered by Ffilm Cymru on behalf of Welsh Government:

- 1. How many short films have been funded with public money in the last three years.
- 2. In which county of Wales is the primary applicant of each of those films based.
- 3. How many of those films are in the Welsh language, fully or partly.
- 4. How many applicants have disclosed any ALN or disability.
- 5. How many of those films have been broadcast publicly.
- 6. How many have made a profit on the public money granted.
- 7. How many of those films were directed by Women.
- 8. How many of those films are set in Wales.
- 9. How many of those films were principally shot in Wales.
- 10. How many applicants have had more than one short film funded with public money administered by Ffilm Cymru. If there are multiple successful applications can you tell me how many each of them received.
- 11. How many successfully funded short film makers have gone on to receive funding for feature length films from Ffilm Cymru.
- 12. How much public money has been granted to short films in each of the last three years.
- 13. How many people make a decision to fund a short film.
- 14. What is the gender balance of those people.
- 15. What is the age range of those people.
- 16. How many of them have worked in the film industry.

Our response

I can confirm that the Welsh Government does not hold the information you have requested. The agreement between the Welsh Government and Ffilm Cymru has only been in place since 1st July this year and is not for the funding of short films.

Next steps

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response.
