Thank you for your request under the Freedom of Information Act received on 4 October 2022. You asked for the following information:

How many council spending cuts have there been? How much does the council make from selling land? How much does the council make from fines, and what is the most profitable type of fine?

What does the council spend the most money on? How much money was spent on bonuses in the council?

The information you requested is not held by the Welsh Government except for one of your questions, as set out below. You appear to be asking for information in relation to a single council but it is not clear which council you are seeking information on. The relevant local authority will be responsible for the other issues you have raised and requests for the above information would have to be submitted directly to that Council.
