I wrote to you on 19<sup>th</sup> October regarding your request for information.

## Information requested

Will you please provide the number of applications submitted to Leasing Scheme Wales since its launch in January 2022?

Will you provide the number of homes successfully leased through the scheme to date?

Can you provide the number of empty homes brought into the Leasing Scheme Wales?

## **Our Response**

I confirm the Welsh Government holds some information caught by your request.

Applications for Leasing Scheme Wales are made directly to local authorities and Welsh Government does not hold this information.

Since its launch in January 2022, 31 properties have been brought onto the scheme and are tenanted, 23 of which were previously empty for six months or more.

An additional 35 properties are tenanted through the Leasing Scheme Wales pathfinder scheme, which pre-dates the national launch in January 2022, providing a total of 66 tenanted properties currently on Leasing Scheme Wales.
