Thank you for your letter of 26 June 2022 to the Minister for Education and Welsh Language regarding Cardiff Council's proposal to replace Cathays High School in Cardiff. I have been asked to reply.

We appreciate your concerns around the development of the Maindy park proposal. I note that we have received correspondence from you previously and it was confirmed that local authorities are responsible for developing their strategic programmes of investment and prioritise projects to progress under the Sustainable Communities for Learning Programme (formerly the 21st Century Schools and Colleges Programme).

To date no business case has been submitted for the proposed expansion of Cathays High School. We do understand that Cardiff Council are working on this proposal, so we suggest that you contact them directly to discuss your concerns further.
