Thank you for your request which I received on 25 October 2022. You asked for the following information:

Please can you provide Diabetes % of patients treated to target for each General Practice in Wales to include:

1. *Blood Pressure*
2. *BP= <140/80*
3. *HbA1c*
4. *HbA1c =< 48mmol (6.5%)*
5. *HbA1c =< 53mmol (7.0%)*
6. *HbA1c =< 58mmol (7.5%)*
7. *HbA1c =< 75mmol (9.0%)*
8. *HbA1c =< 86mmol (10.0%)*
9. *On statins without CVD history*
10. *On statins with CVD history*

Welsh Government publishes the number of people diagnosed with diabetes and the prevalence rate by GP practice on our StatsWales website: [Quality Assurance and Improvement Framework \(QAIF\) disease registers by local health board, cluster and GP practice \(gov.wales\)](https://stats.wales.gov.uk/quality-assurance-and-improvement-framework-qaif-disease-registers-by-local-health-board-cluster-and-gp-practice)
