## Information requested

Thank you for your request which I received on 27 October 2022. You asked for:

Information which the Welsh Government holds on the amount of carbon sequestered though agricultural land use within Wales.

## Our response

Welsh Government does not hold data "on the amount of carbon that is sequestered by land used by agriculture in Wales". Like the other countries of the United Kingdom, Welsh Government assesses carbon emissions and sequestration across the entire economy using the publicly available <a href="UK Greenhouse Gas Inventory">UK Greenhouse Gas Inventory</a> (GHGI).

The GHGI models carbon sequestration, considering a range of land use categories.
