Thank you for your request which I received on 21 October 2022. You asked for the following information, in relation to the First Minister:

- Could you please confirm whether or not you have a second holiday home in West Wales?
- Can you please confirm whether you used that property during the Covid restricted periods? If so, when?

In response to your first question, the First Minister confirmed, in a Welsh Government press conference on 4 July 2022, his family has a chalet in Pembrokeshire. The press conference is available to view at:
