## **Request for Information – ATISN 16879**

I wrote to you on 9 December regarding your request for information.

### **Your Request**

You have asked for the following information:

**Please can you tell me the average speed on the M4 at Newport, captured by the average speed cameras, between 5pm and 6pm over the last month?**

### **Our response**

I can confirm that we do not hold the information you have requested. The average speed cameras were not enforcing until 17 November 2022 and therefore neither the Welsh Government, GoSafe or the Police hold this information.

### **Next steps**
