Thank you for your request which I received on 25 November 2022. You asked the Wales Resilience Forum for:

- 1. Confirmation that it has produced a multi-agency flood plan
- 2. If the answer to 1 is yes, confirmation of the date it was published and the date that the plan was last updated.
- 3. A copy of the latest multi-agency flood plan and/or any similar and relevant current flood prevention plans produced by the LRF.

Our response

I am writing to inform you that the information you have requested is not held by the Welsh Government.

The Wales Resilience Forum is a pan Wales forum for Chief Officers to discuss strategic issues of emergency preparedness with Welsh Ministers. Welsh Government provides secretariat for Wales Resilience Forum. The Wales Resilience Forum does not produce a multi-agency emergency flood plan.

There are four Local Resilience Fora (LRF) in Wales: Gwent, South Wales, Dyfed Powys, and North Wales each with their own detailed and agreed flood plans and arrangements for responding and recovering from flooding. The LRF's can be contacted using the **contact details** below.
