Thank you for your request which I received on 22/11/2022. You asked for: A one year history of all registered owners of farm land and holdings in the Ceredigion area of Wales along with business names, business owners and partners, and live-stock owners/keepers' names.

Our response

I have decided that the information you have requested is exempt from disclosure under regulation 13 of the Environmental Information Regulations and is therefore withheld. I consider the information requested is personal information relating to third parties and that disclosure would contravene UK GDPR principle (a) because there is no lawful basis for processing.

Next steps
