Thank you for your request which I received on 28 November 2022. You asked for the following information:

- 1. Do any buildings or property owned or leased by the Welsh Government (Welsh Government Estate) utilise cameras manufactured by Hikvision or Dahua?
- 2. If so, does the Welsh Government have any plans to remove the technology?
- 3. Does the Welsh Government have any plans to provide councils and agencies with support to uninstall Hikvision cameras that are currently installed across Wales?

I can confirm the referenced equipment is used by Welsh Government and there are currently no plans to remove the technology prior to the end of current arrangements. Regarding part 3 of your request, I can confirm there are no plans for Welsh Government to engage further on this matter.
