## Information requested

Thank you for your request which I received on 13 January 2023. You asked for information to the questions:

- Does the Welsh Government think it appropriate and sensible in a recession for UK tax-payers to pay £227 million to UK-based windfarms to not generate electricity in 2022?
- 2. Of the £227 million mentioned above, what proportion is paid to companies with onshore windfarms located in Wales?
- 3. Of the £227 million, what proportion is paid to companies with offshore windfarms located off the Welsh coast?
- 4. Of the £227 million, what proportion is paid to the Danish company, Vestas, for their windfarms located in Wales?

## Our response

 Does the Welsh Government think it appropriate and sensible in a recession for UK tax-payers to pay £227 million to UK-based windfarms to not generate electricity in 2022?

The request is for an opinion related to a press-release attached to your request; it is not a request for recorded information. The Freedom of Information Act covers recorded information held by a public authority. It does not require the authority to create new information to answer a request, where the information has not been recorded.

4. Of the £227 million, what proportion is paid to the Danish company, Vestas, for their windfarms located in Wales?

The Welsh Government does not hold this information, as it does not have jurisdiction on this matter.
