

**GORCHYMYN CEFNFFORDD YR A465  
(TRAPHONT TAF FECHAN, CEFN COED,  
MERTHYR TUDFUL) (GWAHARDD  
CERBYDAU MAWR DROS DRO) 2023**

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru wedi gwneud Gorchymyn o dan adrannau 14(1)(a), (4) a 15(2) o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984. Mae angen y Gorchymyn er mwyn gwneud gwaith ar gefnffordd yr A465, neu gerllaw iddi, ar Draphont Taf Fechan, Cefn Coed, Merthyr Tudful.

Effaith y Gorchymyn yw gwahardd dros dro bob cerbyd sy'n pwysu 44 tunnell neu fwy rhag mynd ar y darn o'r gefnffordd sy'n ymestyn o bentan dwyreiniol Traphont Taf Fechan, Cefn Coed, Merthyr Tudful i bentan gorllewinol y Draphont.

Y llwybr arall ar gyfer traffig sy'n teithio tua'r gorllewin yw ar hyd yr A4060 tua'r de i Bentre-bach a'r A470 tua'r gogledd i ailymuno â'r A465 wrth Gylchfan Cefn Coed: i'r gwrthwyneb ar gyfer cerbydau sy'n teithio tua'r dwyrain.

Daw'r Gorchymyn i rym ar 1 Ebrill 2023. Disgwylir y bydd y gwaharddiad dros dro yn weithredol o 00:01 o'r gloch ar y dyddiad hwnnw ac yn parhau'n weithredol hyd nes y bydd y gwaith wedi ei gwblhau ac y caiff yr arwyddion traffig dros dro eu symud ymaith yn barhaol. Mae Gweinidogion Cymru wedi eu bodloni y bydd y gwaith yn cymryd mwy na 18 mis i'w orffen.

**THE A465 TRUNK ROAD (TAF FECHAN  
VIADUCT, CEFN COED, MERTHYR TYDFIL)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF LARGE  
VEHICLES) ORDER 2023**

The Welsh Ministers have made an Order under sections 14(1)(a), (4) and 15(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order is necessary to undertake works on or near the A465 trunk road at Taf Fechan Viaduct, Cefn Coed, Merthyr Tydfil.

The effect of the Order is to temporarily prohibit all vehicles with a weight of or over 44 tonnes from proceeding on the length of the trunk road that extends from the eastern abutment to the western abutment of Taf Fechan Viaduct, Cefn Coed, Merthyr Tydfil.

The alternative route for westbound vehicles is via the southbound A4060 to Pentrebach and northbound A470 to rejoin the A465 at Cefn Coed Roundabout: vice versa for eastbound vehicles.

The Order comes into force on 1 April 2023. The temporary prohibition is expected to operate from 00:01 hours on that date and will remain operational until the works are complete and the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed. The Welsh Ministers are satisfied that the works will take longer than 18 months.
