## **ATISN 17264 Freedom of Information request - SEN Funding**

### **Information requested**

Thank you for your request which I received on 13 March 2023. You asked for:

The Welsh Government to provide the amount of SEN funding given to each Local Authority over the last three years.

### **Our response**

The Revenue Support Grant (RSG) includes provision of education and support for learners with ALN. This provides most school funding to local authorities by the Welsh Government.

Once the RSG is distributed, it is the responsibility of individual authorities to set budgets for their schools and the local provision that they support. This approach to funding is a key part of the Welsh Government's policy that local authorities are best placed to deliver services in line with the requirements and circumstances of their population, to which they are accountable.

In addition to funding allocated via the RSG, the Welsh Government continues to make available significant additional grant funding.

The information on additional grant funding is attached.

### **Next steps**
