THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CARDIGAN (BUILT-UP AREAS) ORDER, 1936.

WHEREAS the County Council of Cardigan (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") is the local authority within the meaning of Section 1 of the Road Traffic Act, 1934, as respects the lengths of road specified in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the said roads"):

AND WHEREAS no system of street lighting furnished by means of lamps placed not more than 200 yards apart is provided on the said roads and accordingly the said roads are not roads in built-up areas within the meaning of sub-section (1)(a) of the said Section 1:

AND WHEREAS the Council having given public notice of their intention to make an Order directing that the said roads shall be deemed to be roads in built-up areas and having consulted with the Chief Officer of Police for the County of Cardigan are satisfied that such direction should be given.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by subsection (4) of Section 1 of the Road Traffic Act, 1934, and

of every other power for that behalf them thereunto enabling, hereby order and direct that the said roads shall be deemed to be roads in built-up areas notwithstanding that such a system of lighting as aforesaid is not provided thereon.

The Interpretation Act, 1889, applies for the purpose of the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the purpose of the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

This Order may be cited as "The County Council of Cardigan (Built-up Areas) Order, 1936."

SCHEDULE.

*ABERFORTH.

Commencing on Route B. 4333 at a point 20 yards north of its junction with the road to Traeth Saith, thence in a north-westerly, westerly, north-westerly and south-westerly direction through the village of Aberporth to a point 100 yards south-west of the south-west wall of the Methodist Chapel. Length, 1,065 yards.

* FELINFACH AND YSTRAD.

- (i) Route A.482. From a point 139 yards north-west of St Michaels Church Gate south-eastwards to a point 123 yards south-east of its junction with Route B.4342 at Felinfach. Length, 1,110 yards.
- (ii) Route B.4342 at Ystrad. From its junction with Route A.482 near the Vicarage to a point 50 yards south-west of that junction. Length 50 yards.
- (iii) Route B.4342 at Felinfach. From its junction with Route A.482 near the School to a point 123 yards south-east of that junction. Length 123 yards.

* LLANON.

- (i) Route A.487. From a point 90 yards north-east of the north abutment of the north bridge (over Afon Peris) south-westwards to a point 10 yards north-east of its junction with the road to Penant. Length 910 yards.
- (ii) Unclassified Road from Llanon to Nebo. From its junction with Route A.487 to a point 200 yards east thereof. Length 200 yards.

* LLANARTH.

- (i) Route A.437. From a point 30 yards south-west of its junction with the road to Felinfach (Route B.4342) south-westwards to a point 40 yards south-west of the south-west corner of the Llanina Arms Public House. Length 566 yards.
- (ii) Route B. 4342 (Road to Newquay). From its junction with Route A.437 to a point 40 yards north-west thereof. Length 40 yards.
- (iii) Penceae Road, unclassified. From its junction with Route A.437 to a point 60 yards south-east thereof. Length 60 yards.

Route A.44. From a point 100 yards north of the north corner of the west abutment of the Great Western Railway over-bridge south-westwards to a point 60 yards south-west of its junction with Llanychaearn Road at Figure Four. Length 706 yards.

(ii) Route A.485. From its junction with Route A.487 to a point 60 yards south-east thereof. Length 60 yards.

(iii) Llanychaearn Road, unclassified. From its junction with Route A.487 at Figure Four to a point 40 yards north-west thereof. Length 40 yards.

ROY STREET.

(i) Route A.487. From a point 60 yards north-east of the north-east wall of the Y.M.C.A. Hall south-westwards to a point 3 yards south-west of the south-west wall of the house known as "Glen View". Length 1,567 yards.

(ii) Clarsach Road, unclassified. From its junction with Route A.487 to a point 50 yards west thereof. Length 50 yards.

(iii) Pencwm Road, unclassified. From its junction with Route A.487 to a point 140 yards south-east thereof. Length 140 yards.

PONTERWYD

(i) Route A.44. From a point 20 yards north-east of the north-east wall of the house known as "Blaen Pentre" southwards to a point 100 yards north-east of the north-east wall of the Gogerddan Arms Hotel. Length 570 yards.

(ii) Route A.4120. From its junction with Route A.44 to a point 100 yards south-east thereof. Length 100 yards.



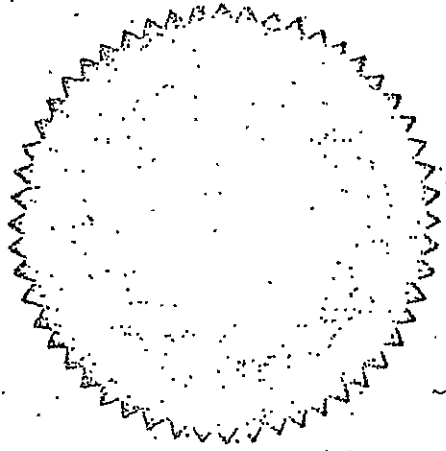
