

**GORCHYMYN CEFNFFORDD YR A470
(DOLWEN, I'R GOGLEDD-DDWYRAIN O
LANIDLOES, POWYS) (GWAHARDD
CERBYDAU DROS DRO) 2023**

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru wedi gwneud Gorchymyn o dan adran 14 o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984. Mae angen y Gorchymyn er mwyn gwneud gwaith ar gefnffordd yr A470, neu gerllaw iddi, ger Dolwen, i'r gogledd-ddwyrain o Lanidloes, Powys.

Effaith y Gorchymyn yw gwahardd dros dro bob cerbyd, ac eithrio'r rhai a ddefnyddir gan y gwasanaethau brys neu ar gyfer y gwaith, rhag mynd ar y darn o gefnffordd yr A470 sy'n ymestyn o bwynt 150 o fetrau i'r gogledd-ddwyrain o ganolbwynt ei chyffordd â'r C2023 i Ddolwen hyd at bwynt 100 metr i'r gorllewin o ganolbwynt ei chyffordd â'r U2775 i Rallt. Sicrheir mynediad i eiddo ar hyd y darn a fydd ar gau a rheolir hynny gan y sawl sy'n gyfrifol am reoli traffig.

Y llwybr arall ar gyfer pob cerbyd arall sy'n teithio tua'r gorllewin yw'r A470 tua'r gogledd i Gaersŵs, y B4569 tua'r gorllewin ac yna tua'r de drwy Drefeglwys i Lanidloes a'r B4518 Victoria Avenue tua'r dwyrain i ailymuno â'r A470: i'r gwrthwyneb ar gyfer cerbydau sy'n teithio tua'r dwyrain.

Daw'r Gorchymyn i rym ar 19 Mai 2023. Disgwylir y bydd y gwaharddiad dros dro yn weithredol o 20:00 o'r gloch ar 19 Mai tan 06:00 o'r gloch ar 20 Mai 2023 neu hyd nes y caiff yr arwyddion traffig dros dro eu symud ymaith yn barhaol.

Dim ond yn ystod y cyfnod a bennir uchod y disgwylir i'r Gorchymyn fod yn weithredol. Er hynny, bydd yn parhau'n ddilys am gyfnod o 18 mis ar y mwyaf rhag ofn y bydd angen ailamserlennu'r gwaith neu wneud gwaith canlyniadol neu waith arall. Bydd hysbysiad am unrhyw newidiadau i'r amseroedd a'r dyddiadau yn cael ei arddangos cyn gwneud unrhyw waith a ailamserlennir.

**THE A470 TRUNK ROAD (DOLWEN, NORTH-
EAST OF LLANIDLOES, POWYS)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES)
ORDER 2023**

The Welsh Ministers have made an Order under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which is required to undertake works on or near the A470 trunk road near Dolwen, north-east of Llanidloes, Powys.

The effect of the Order is to temporarily prohibit all vehicles, other than those being used by the emergency services or for the works, from proceeding on the length of the A470 trunk road that extends from a point 150 metres north-east of the centre-point of its junction with the C2023 to Dolwen to a point 100 metres west of the centre-point of its junction with the U2775 to Rallt. Access will be maintained to properties within the length of the closure and this will be managed by the traffic management operatives.

The alternative route for all other westbound vehicles is via the northbound A470 to Caersŵs, the westbound then southbound B4569 via Trefeglwys to Llanidloes and eastbound B4518 Victoria Avenue to rejoin the A470: vice versa for eastbound vehicles.

The Order comes into force on 19 May 2023. The temporary prohibition is expected to operate from 20:00 hours on 19 May until 06:00 hours on 20 May 2023 or until the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Although the Order is only expected to operate during the period specified above it will remain valid for a maximum period of 18 months, as a contingency, should the work need to be rescheduled or consequential or other work is required. Notice of any changes to times and dates will be displayed before any rescheduled work begins.
