**Stage Two - Refinement of Priority Areas for Renewable Energy**

**Variation of Contract**

We refer to the above referenced Contract between you and the Welsh Ministers.

The project is being extended to include Stage Two - Refinement of Priority Areas for Renewable Energy. This entails the refinement of the initial areas identified as being of greatest opportunity for on-shore wind and solar energy development, including an Assessment of Landscape and Visual Sensitivity, and to make recommendation for the Priority Areas for Renewable Energy to be identified in the NDF.

As a result, we wish to vary the Contract set out in this letter agreement with effect from 26 February 2019 (the "Variation Date").

In this letter agreement, expressions defined in the Contract and used in this letter agreement have the meaning set out in the Contract.

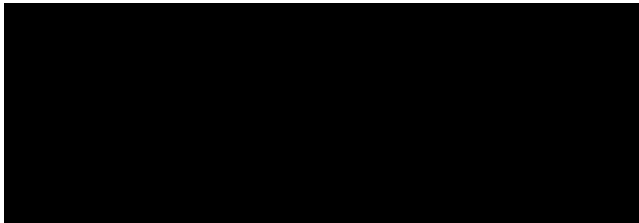
With effect from the Variation Date, we propose the variations to the Contract to include the Stage Two - Refinement of Priority Areas for Renewable Energy work, as set out in our enclosed 'Specification' and your 'Quality Response' and 'Commercial Response Form'. The Contract has been extended to the 26 April 2019 and the contract value increased to £88,314.27.

Except as provided in this letter, the Contract shall continue in full force and effect. This letter agreement and any dispute or claim (including non-contractual disputes or claims) arising out of or in connection with it, its subject matter or formation shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of England and Wales as applied in Wales.

All disputes arising under or in connection with it shall, subject to the dispute resolution condition set out in the Standard Conditions, be submitted in the first instance to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts in Cardiff.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this letter to acknowledge your agreement to the variation of the Contract as set out in this letter.

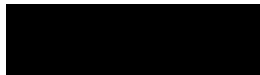
