A list of all planning appeals conducted by PEDW (and formerly Planning Inspectorate Wales) from 2002-2022, including the date of the appeal and the procedure followed (e.g. inquiry, hearing or written representation)

Please find attached a spreadsheet, with two separately completed tabs. The sheet on the first tab lists the number of planning appeals issued in the year. The second tab breaks down that number by;

- 1. The reference number
- 2. The year of issue,
- 3. The local planning authority (LPA),
- 4. The type of appeal,
- 5. The date of the event.
- 6. The date of the decision, (a-allowed d- dismissed)
- 7. The procedure followed, (i inquiry, h hearing, w-written representations)
- 8. The outcome and
- 9. The jurisdiction (TR/TX indicates a decision made by the Welsh Ministers).

Each column can be filtered to break down the information to what is required. You will also note that we cannot provide detail of the date of the event before April 2017 as we do not hold this information.
