Request for Information – ATISN 18852

Thank you for your request for information dated 17 August 2023.

Information requested

You asked for clarification of the quoted text: “Police data from 2018 shows that about 50 per cent of the 5,759 casualties in road accidents in Wales happened on 30 mph roads and only 2 per cent in 20 mph zones”. Specifically:

1. How many different 30 mph zones were used to provide the 50 per cent of the 5,759 casualties in road accidents in Wales?
2. How many 20 mph zones were used in calculating the 2 per cent of the 5,759 casualties in road accidents in Wales?

Our response

1. We do not hold information on the number of 20mph and 30mph zones within our police recorded road accident data system. However, we recently published statistics on: [Estimated road length by road speed limit in Wales as of 2021](#).
2. For your information, data on road casualties by speed limit are published in the WG annual publication [Reported road casualties Wales, 2022 \(gov.wales\)](#)

When considering the number of casualties by road speed, it’s important to consider both the total length of roads across Wales by each speed limit, as well as the volume of traffic travelling on these roads.

Next steps
