The the cost per council for the cost of the new 20mph signage.

Our response

Please see the attached link – In the [Regulatory Impact Assessment](#) undertaken in 2022 it was estimated that the total cost of traffic regulation orders by highway authorities, for exceptions to the 20mph default speed limit, will be £1.1 million. We do not have a figure for the number of signs that will be involved, this information is held by each individual highway authority. The estimated cost for changes to traffic signs and road markings is £26.7 million.
