- 1. Does the Health Board have or had a contract with Lynn Global (or associated names or previous names).
- 2. If Yes was this negotiated by NHS Shared Services?
- 3. What are the names of any other business that have been contracted to provide PR support to the Board?
- 4. For what purpose are PR contracts in place for?
- 5. On what occasions have the Health Board brought in a PR company to develop messages following a failure in the delivery of a service that resulted in the death if a patient.
- 6. How many managers have undergone PR training to deal with the media on negative Health issues.
- 7. What is the total spend on contracts with PR companies split between a retainer contract and those for specific issues.
