He said: "Last night (Sunday) at 18.57, the UK Government sent some of the evidence that we have repeatedly requested. It is hugely regrettable that the evidence that has apparently been developed over the summer has been withheld until the night before the first day back of term. It is also incomplete, leaving us without the full rationale for the DfE's sudden policy change towards the management of RAAC in schools"

I'm interested in the evidence provided at 18:57 on Sunday, 2 September.

Our response:

Following your request, the information requested was assessed and it was noted that it was provided in confidence, and marked as such, by the UK Government's Department for Education (DfE). I have, therefore, decided that the information described above is exempt from disclosure under section 41 of the Freedom of Information Act and is therefore withheld.
