I understand that a recent inspection by Cadw found that the Rompney Castle was not considered a viable building to be considered for a listed building status.

My constituents have raised concerns that no internal inspection was made of the building. The community group believe that this particular building and site date back to 75AD when the Romans build Caer Castel.

My constituents have raised concerns that due to delayed responses from Cadw they were not afforded time to lodge a reply or appeal the inspection report.
