Information requested

Thank you for your request which I received on 21 September 2023. You asked:

How much funding has been diverted from other areas of the transport budget to pay for the rollout of 20 mph speed limits in Wales. List the other areas and a breakdown of funds taken from those areas to pay for it.

Our response

Funding for 20mph implementation in Welsh Government sits within the Road Safety budget. In 2023/24 a transfer of £18.4m capital funding was made from the Local Transport Fund budget to the road safety budget. A number of other transfers were made into the Local Transport Fund which partly offset this transfer. The full list of budget transfers is set out below.

Road Safety	£	16,717,200
Sustainable & Active Travel	£	2,047,800
Bus Support	-£	10,000,000
Local Transport Priorities	-£	8,765,000
