ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A487 Trunk Road (Lay-by at Llanfarian, Ceredigion) (One Way Traffic) Order 2023

Made 31 October 2023

Coming into force 2 November 2023

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A487 trunk road, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 1(1), 2(1) and 2(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

The Welsh Ministers have consulted with the Chief Officer of Dyfed Powys Police and given public notice of their intention to make this Order in accordance with regulations 5(1) and 6(1) of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1990(2).

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A487 Trunk Road (Lay-by at Llanfarian, Ceredigion) (One Way Traffic) Order 2023 and this Order comes into force on 2 November 2023.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

ystyr “y gefnffordd” (“*the trunk road*”) yw cefnffordd yr A487 Abergwaun i Fangor.

Gwaharddiad

3. Ni chaiff neb beri na chaniatáu i unrhyw gerbyd fynd i unrhyw gyfeiriad ac eithrio tua’r gogledd ar y darn cyfan o cilfan y gefnffordd sy’n dechrau wrth y gyffordd â Penffordd Road ac sy’n gorffen wrth gyffordd y ffordd fynediad i’r Ystâd Dai yn Llanfarian, Ceredigion.

“lay-by” (“*cilfan*”) means any area of the trunk road intended for the waiting of vehicles, which is situated at the side of the trunk road bounded either wholly or partly by road markings of the type shown in diagram 1010 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016(1);

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A487 Fishguard to Bangor trunk road.

Prohibition

3. No person may cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in any direction other than northbound on the entire length of the lay-by of the trunk road which begins at the junction with Penffordd Road and ends at the junction of the access road to the Housing Estate at Llanfarian, Ceredigion.
