ATISN 19161 – Lead Paint Consent

Thank you for your request which I received on Friday 13 October. You asked:

Since 1992, (i) how many approvals for the lawful use of lead paint has Cadw given out, in total; (ii) how many declarations of lawful use (before we approved them) has Cadw received, in total; (iii) how many times, in total, has Cadw refused a declaration of lawful use for lead paint and (iv) how many different individual applicants, bodies or companies has Cadw received declarations/requests for approvals from, in total.

Our response

Approvals for lawful use of lead paint	37
Declarations received	40
Declarations refused	3 (see note 1)
Declarations / requests for approvals from individual applicants, bodies or	40
companies received by Cadw.	

This information is drawn from documentary evidence in paper files A/CAL18/07/002 part 1 (1999-2004) and A/CAL18/07/002 part 2 (2005-2012) and one electronic file for restoration of a work of fine art in 2020. A third file, which we assume covered a period from 1992 has been destroyed.

 Note 1. Approval can only be awarded for use of lead paint in Grade I and Grade II (starred) listed buildings. The three refused were mistakenly identified as Grade II (starred) but were in fact Grade II (unstarred).
