Information requested

Thank you for your request which I received on 24 October 2023. You asked for:

- 1. Information on how the Welsh Government's period dignity grant has improved school attendance for girls aged 10-18 since 2017.
- 2. All letters and emails received by Jenny Rathbone MS from the 1st of March 2023 to the 24th of October 2023 on the issue of period poverty.

Our response

1. We do not hold statistics on school absence levels due to period related issues, so we do not have statistical evidence on whether the Welsh Government's Period Dignity Grant improved school attendance for girls aged 10-18 since 2017. However, the evaluation of the Period Dignity Grant, published on 26 October 2023, does show evidence that free period products and information provided via the grant, made it less likely that learners would miss out on school, sports or other social activities when menstruating.
