Your request

You have asked for the following information regarding Childcare Consequentials from the UK Government.

- 1. How much money was given in respect to childcare?
- 2. Where is that money now?

Our response

For question one, Welsh Government received £12.1m in 2023-24 and £128.4m in 2024-25 in consequentials as part of the UK Spring Statement on the 15th of March.

For question two, The Welsh Government's overall settlement received as part of a UK fiscal event, is comprised of both positive and negative consequentials. The 2023-24 consequentials have been included in the Welsh Government's spending plans published in the first supplementary budget in June 2023.

The allocations for 2024-25 will be managed through the annual Draft Budget process, which is currently underway, and will be published on the 19th of December. These plans can be accessed via the Welsh Government website (follow the link to Welsh Government Budgets) following the publication on the 19th of December.
