

**GORCHYMYN CEFNFFORDD YR A470
(CILFAN Y GERBYTFFORDD TUA'R DE I'R
GOGLEDD O FETWS-Y-COED,

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru wedi gwneud Gorchymyn o dan adran 14 o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984. Mae angen y Gorchymyn er mwyn gwneud gwaith ar gefnffordd yr A470, neu gerllaw iddi, i'r gogledd o Fetws-y-coed, Bwrdeistref Sirol Conwy.

Effaith y Gorchymyn fydd gwahardd dros dro bob cerbyd, beiciwr a cherddwr, ar wahân i'r rai y mae angen mynediad arnynt at ddibenion y gwaith, rhag mynd i'r gilfan ar gerbyttffordd tua'r de cefnffordd yr A470 a leolir 435 o fetrau i'r gogledd o fynedfa safle Zip World ym Metws-y-coed, i'r gogledd o Fetws-y-coed.

Daw'r gwaharddiadau dros dro, y codir arwyddion priodol yn eu cylch, i rym am 00:01 o'r gloch ar 8 Ionawr 2024 a byddant yn parhau tan 23:59 o'r gloch ar 31 Mawrth 2024 neu nes y caiff yr arwyddion cau dros dro eu symud ymaith yn barhaol.

Dim ond yn ystod y dyddiadau a bennir uchod y disgwylir i'r Gorchymyn fod yn weithredol. Er hynny, bydd yn parhau'n ddilys am gyfnod o 12 mis ar y mwyaf rhag ofn y bydd angen ailamserlennu'r gwaith neu wneud gwaith canlyniadol neu waith arall. Bydd hysbysiad ymlaen llaw am unrhyw newidiadau i'r amseroedd a'r dyddiadau'n cael ei arddangos cyn gwneud unrhyw waith a ailamserlennir.

**THE A470 TRUNK ROAD (SOUTHBOUND
LAYBY SITUATED NORTH OF BETWS-Y-
COED, CONWY COUNTY BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES,
CYCLISTS AND PEDESTRIANS) ORDER 2023**

The Welsh Ministers have made an Order under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which is necessary whilst works are undertaken on or near the A470 trunk road, north of Betws-y-Coed, Conwy County Borough.

The effect of the Order will be to temporarily prohibit all vehicles, cyclists and pedestrians, other than those being used for the works, from entering the southbound layby on the A470 trunk road located 435 metres north of the entrance to the Zip World Betws-y-Coed Site, north of Betws-y-Coed.

The temporary prohibitions, which will be signed accordingly, will come into force at 00:01 hours on 8 January 2024 and remain until 23:59 hours on 31 March 2024 or until the temporary closure signs are permanently removed.

Although the Order is only expected to operate during the dates specified above it will remain valid for a maximum period of 12 months as a contingency, should the work need to be rescheduled or consequential or other work is required. Advance notice of any changes to times and dates will be displayed before any rescheduled work.
