- 2 Any correspondence between NHS Wales officials and Lottie Dominiczak.

(This should include any messages in any format and private channels such as WhatsApp, direct messages, texts, voice recordings and personal email accounts)

3 Any minutes relating to meetings in which NHS Wales officials and representatives of Uber and/or Lottie Dominiczak were present.

## **Our Response**

After a search of our records, we can confirm that the Welsh Government does not hold the information that you have requested. You may wish to consider requesting the information from NHS Wales. NHS Wales is made up of seven Local Health Boards, three NHS Trusts and two Special Health Authorities.
