Information requested

Thank you for your request which I received on 2 January. You asked for information regarding labour party proposals to give £1,600 per month to asylum seekers, including legal authority to do so and details of any Senedd vote on the proposals.

Our response

We do not hold information in relation to your request as there is no labour party proposal to give £1600 a month to asylum seekers.

However, I believe you are referring to the Basic Income for Care Leavers in Wales pilot, which was subject to misleading press stories last year. The pilot was launched in July 2022 and was open to young people turning 18 and leaving care between 1 July 2022 and 30 June 2023. The pilot is explained in more detail here: <u>Basic income pilot for care leavers: overview of the scheme | GOV.WALES</u>.
