- 1) How much has the Welsh Government spent on private commercial solicitors to advise lease holders on building safety issues in each of the five last financial years.

Our response

The information is as follows:

- The Welsh Government has not spent any monies on private commercial solicitors to advise leaseholders on building safety issues in each of the five last financial years.
- 2) The total expenditure that the Welsh Government has made on legal advice for building safety issues is £80,661,77. The period covers financial years 2021 to date and is in respect of external legal advice.
