Thank you for your request which I received on 13th April 2023. You asked for:

- 1) minutes from the meetings held by the Anti Racism Action Plan Implementation Team from Thursday 14th July 2022, and any other minutes held by the Team from July-March 2023
- 2) The proportion of the membership committee that are institutions or official bodies, and the percentage that are grassroots activists or community campaigners. You also asked what proportion of these committees are under the age of thirty.
- 3) How the committee recruited for the diversity representatives with lived experience along with any recruitment documentation
- 4) A communication plan for the Anti-racist Wales Action Plan

As requested, the following are attached:
