- 3. What will the total cost be for changing the electoral system to the D'Hondt system and how is this calculated?
- 4. What will the total cost be for making 16 new Senedd constituencies and how is this calculated?
- 5. What will the total cost be for increasing the number of new Ministers and how is it broken down in terms of Ministerial salaries, office staff numbers and salaries, office space, expenses and operating costs?
- 6. What will the total cost be of enabling MSs to elect a second Deputy Presiding Officer?
- 7. Will there also be an accompanying increase in Welsh Government Civil Service numbers and if yes how many and in which departments or divisions?
