Thank you for your request which I received on 1 March 2024. You asked for:

 financial sponsorship or donations that have been made to any part or member of the Welsh Assembly including ministers (made by the list of provided officers and or companies).

Further to our request, you clarified:

- the request was in relation to Ministers and Welsh Government officials;
- 'made' is any offer and whether or not it was accepted;
- information was sought on each financial sponsorship and/or donation received by the listed official or organisation (split by accepted and/or declined – with the associated value); and
- The time period should cover the last 10 financial years (or as much of that as you are able to, broken down by year).

Information for Ministers/Officials is exempt under Section 21 of the Freedom of Information Act (2000) – information reasonably accessible to the requester by other means.

## **Ministerial Information**

Registration of sponsorship and donations is a requirement under the standing orders of the Welsh Parliament and are available to view online for each MS, which includes Ministers. The sixth assembly register can be found here <u>Register of Members' Interests (senedd.wales)</u> – the webpage includes archives of the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Senedd terms which covers the requested time period.

## Officials

Details of any sponsorship and donations to officials would be recorded in Group Gift and Hospitality registers. Welsh Government Gift and Hospitality information has previously been published and covers most of the time period of your request – the most recent was:

ATISN <u>FOI release 19016: Gifts | GOV.WALES</u> which asked for Gifts and Hospitality received by Welsh Government officials, and in particular the total value of gifts and hospitality received for the years 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022 and 2023.
