Award of Funding in relation to Local Transport Fund – North Wales Metro, Resilient Roads Fund & Ultra Low Emissions Vehicle Transformation Fun Grants for Financial Year 2021/22 – Isle of Anglesey County Council

REVISED GRANT FUNDING – Local Transport Fund

This letter is in relation to revising the Local Transport Fund element of the award letter. A revised schedule 1 is attached.

The award is made under the authority of the Minister for Climate Change, one of the Welsh Ministers. This brings the total amount allocated to Local Transport Fund, Resilient Roads Fund and Ultra Low Emissions Vehicle Transformation Fund for Financial Year 2021/2022 – Isle of Anglesey County Council - £1,400,300 (*one million, four hundred thousand and three hundred pounds*)

The Funding has been allocated as follows:

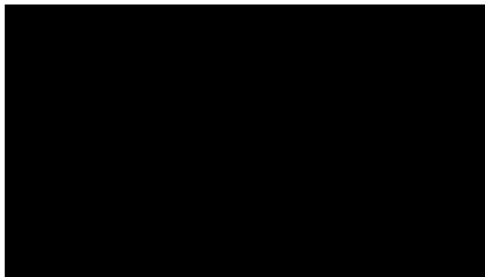
- **Local Transport Fund – North Wales Metro** of up to £975,000 (nine hundred and seventy five thousand pounds)
- **Local Transport Fund** of up to £41,300 (forty one thousand and three hundred pounds)
- **Resilient Roads Fund** of up to £220,000 (two hundred and twenty thousand pounds)
- **Ultra Low Emissions Vehicle Transformation Fund** of up to £164,000 (one hundred and sixty four thousand pounds)

The statutory basis for this Funding is sections section 58A of the Government of Wales Act 2006, section 31 of the Local Government Act 2007, section 6 of the Transport for (Wales) Act 2006 and Active Travel Wales Act (Wales) 2013.

This adjustment in funding is subject to the terms and conditions provided in the original Funding award letter dated 19 March 2021.

In order to accept this adjustment in funding and confirm that you accept the Terms and Conditions you must sign and return a copy of this letter to Transport Planning, Cathays Park, Cardiff, CF10 3NQ. None of the Funding will be paid to you until we have received your signed letter. We must receive your signed letter within 14 days of the date of this letter, or this award of Funding will automatically be withdrawn.
