Dear Minister,

I have met with many farmers in the Royal Welsh Show this week. One topic of discussion is the imminent changes to the planning rules in England that will allow Farmers to host temporary campsites for up to 60 days per year.

Could you confirm whether Welsh Government are looking to introduce similar here in Wales?

If there is to be no change to the current 28 day rule in Wales, this will place many Farmers, particularly in the border areas in my constituency, at a considerable disadvantage to their counterparts in England.

At a time when Farmers need to diversify and have multiple income streams, I ask that you give consideration to adopting the same 60 day rule here in Wales. If you will not consider this rule change, I would be grateful to learn how you intend to support Farmers in the border areas of my constituency so that they are not financially disadvantaged by the Welsh planning system.
