I wrote to you on 5 April regarding your request for information.

Your Request

You asked for the following information regarding the M4:

- 1) Accident data for the M4 westbound at Jt 43 for the years 2018-2023
- 2) You have raised issued about drainage in a certain area ("I believe the area I am interested in is in cutting joust east of the full motorway width gantry") which is a different area from the original information provided by our Trunk Road Agents in March this year.
- 3) You also wish to know when the drainage system filter stone was last renewed.

Our Response

I can confirm the Welsh Government does hold some of the information you have requested.

- 1) The Table in Annex A sets out the accident data for Jt43 for the years 2018-2022. We do not yet have the accident data for 2023.
- 2) From your description we believe Annex B shows the gullies and inspection for the area you requested.
- 3) We do not have the date when the drainage system filter stone was last renewed.

Next steps


Data extracted for the calendar years 2018 to 2022.
