Thank you for your request which I received on 20 January 2025. You asked for this information for the year 2023 (01/01/2023 to 31/12/2023):

- 1) How much money did the Welsh Government grant in total to Cardiff University in 2023 for scientific research involving the use of animals under ASPA?
- 2) Please supply a breakdown of the funding provided eg Quality Related, funding via named Government funding bodies or specific initiatives/programmes.
- 3) How much money did the Welsh Government grant in total to Swansea University in 2023 for scientific research involving the use of animals under ASPA?
- 4) Please supply a breakdown of the funding provided e.g. Quality Related, funding via named Government funding bodies or specific initiatives/programmes.

Our response

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that no such information is held for Cardiff University because no such grants were awarded. However, I can confirm that a grant was awarded to Swansea University in the timeframe you specify for scientific research involving the use of animals under the Animals (Scientific Procedures) Act 1986.

The grant amount of £39,828 was awarded through the Marine Protected Area Management Grant Scheme and covered research involving twait shad in the

Severn estuary. The grant enabled Swansea university to collect and tag a number of twait shad to understand more about their migratory patterns.
