Llansteffan North Green Car Park - Notification Event

Following on from the meeting of the 24th September, 2024 with your grant officers I write to confirm a Notification Event relating to the above project.


The improvement of the North Green Car Park was dependent on the Llanybri & Llansteffan Community Council, owners of part of the land, entering into an agreement with Carmarthenshire County Council which would enable the County Council, owners of the other part of the land, to undertake improvement works to the existing parking area and to manage and maintain the facility on a long-term lease arrangement.

Unfortunately, the Clerk to Llanybri & Llansteffan Community Council has informed the County Council that, having considered the matter in some detail, the Community Council are no longer prepared to enter into an agreement.

The development of the facility was a longstanding ambition by the local community and captured within the Llanstaffen Action Plan produced in November 2022. The Action Plan can be viewed at:

Despite further detailed conversation and consideration it has been concluded that the improvement project for which you have so kindly provided grant funding cannot proceed further.
