Information requested

Thank you for your request which I received on 31 January 2025. You asked for:

The names of refuge spaces in north Wales that can house women who have experienced sexual assault, exploitation and substance misuse.

Our response

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that the information you require is not held by the Welsh Government.

Information detailing the names and addresses of refuge spaces is extremely sensitive given the safeguarding considerations for residents, and therefore is only accessed and shared with those services who directly support women and individuals in need.

Next steps

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response.
