Thank you for your request for information dated 5 February.

Information requested

You asked us if we could provide the following detail relating to the Dee Coastal Path cycle project 2004 and 2005:

1. Information pertaining to the grant (including the original grant application, any subsequent grant applications, approval letters and any grant terms and conditions), including all appendices and attachments.
2. Update reports or progress reports from the project submitted to Welsh Government and any responses from Welsh Government.
3. Any evaluations undertaken on the project since completion.

Our response

After conducting a historical record check, we were unable to locate any information that falls within the scope of your request.

Please be advised that our organisation adheres to strict retention and destruction policies. Most information is systematically destroyed after a predetermined period, with only specific types of information retained as required by our policies.

Given that the information is 20 years old, it is likely that any records we held would have been destroyed in accordance with our retention policy.
