Request for Information - ATISN 24439

Thank you for your request for information which was received on 24 February 2025.

You have asked for the full monetary cost of the active travel scheme at Brynich Roundabout, Brecon, which was completed in 2024.

Our Response

I can confirm the Welsh Government holds the information you requested.

The total construction cost for the active travel path (including crossings) is £132,758. The footway relocation is essential to accommodate the installation of vehicle contraflow crossovers on the Brecon Bypass. These crossovers are being introduced to minimise disruption during future essential bypass maintenance activities. As a result, the original pedestrian route will be severed, and it therefore requires redirecting.

We have taken the opportunity to upgrade the footway to a shared use path in accordance with Active Travel (Wales) Design Guidance standards. The shared use path links nearby settlements and caravan parks with Brecon, and there are longer term proposals to extend this further afield.

Next steps
