The Welsh Ministers have been asked to consider using their intervention powers under Section 182 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 to take enforcement action in relation to pre-commencement conditions attached to planning permission P/2014/067, which allowed the following development.

Construct and operate 7 wind turbines with a maximum height of 110m and maximum hub height of 69m together with ancillary development comprising substation, control building, new and upgraded access points and tracks, hardstanding and temporary compound and associated works: Hendy Wind Farm, land off A44, SW of Llandegley, Llandrindod Wells, Powys.

Following our usual procedure, we are contacting your Council to consult with you to request details as to whether or not your Authority has received a request asking it to consider taking enforcement action on this site, and if so, what response your Authority has provided to the requestor.

Please could I ask for a response by 19 April, if at all possible.
