SBUHB have advised that they have received requests from ITV for a statement.

Furthermore, we have been informed that Sky News are running a story this evening regarding a family that are spokespeople for a parents group calling for an independent inquiry into SBUHB and one other woman. The family have been in regular contact with the Welsh Government and are known to us. SBUHB have not provided the details of Sky News request, however, officials have had sight of the health boards statement issued to Sky News. Unfortunately, we do not have a definitive time this news slot will air.

Welsh Government have not been approached for a statement to date, however, Officials have prepared press lines should they be required.
