# ATISN 24533 - Reclassification of Plas Carmel by Aelwyd Housing

## Information requested

Thank you for your request which I received on 13 March 2025. You asked:

- 1. Has Aelwyd Housing Association formally changed the classification of Plas Carmel from sheltered accommodation to social housing social housing?
- 2. If so, when was this change approved, and what process did Aelwyd HA follow?
- 3. Were residents consulted before this decision was made, as required under housing regulations?
- 4. What are the regulatory requirements for such a change, and were these requirements met?

### Our response

In relation to question 1, sheltered accommodation provided by housing associations is normally classified as social housing. We have therefore presumed you refer to a change from sheltered housing to general needs social housing and answered on that basis. Should this not be the case, please get back in touch.

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that the information you require in questions 1, 2 and 3 above is not held by the Welsh Government.

In relation to question 4, there are no specific regulatory requirements relating to the reclassification of a property from sheltered housing to general needs social housing. However registered social landlords are expected to comply with the <u>Regulatory Standards</u>,
