Thank you for your request which I received on 17 March 2025. You asked for:

 the total funding the Welsh Government has supplied to the WRU, since 2020.

## Our response

Since 2020, the Welsh Government has provided four separate funding contributions; two directly to the Welsh Rugby Union (WRU) and two to the Millennium Stadium PLC, a subsidiary of the WRU. The total amount is £4,975,373.

Details are provided below:

In addition to the above allocations the Welsh Government has a commercial loan agreement for £18m with the WRU, which falls within the time scale you have stipulated.
