## ATISN 24611 - Welfare Reform

Thank you for your request which I received in two parts on 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2025. You asked for:

- Copies of any written correspondence between the First Minister and Liz Kendall, Secretary of State for Work and Pensions in relation to the recent announcement on reform to benefits for disabled people.
- 2. A copy of any correspondence between the First Minister and the Chancellor and the Prime Minister's office.
- Any documents or analysis by Welsh Government that has been done by Welsh
  government ministers or civil servants in relation to the welfare reforms announced by
  the UK Government. In particular, the impact of these reforms on disabled people in
  Wales and the services accessed e.g. Welsh Government hardship fund, social
  services, health.

## Our response (to date of FOI request):

1. The initial letter from the First Minister to the Secretary of State for Wales has been published as part of a previous FOI request (ATISN 24560) and can be found here FOI release 24560: Welfare Reforms | GOV.WALES

2. There has been no correspondence on this matter between the First Minister, Prime Minister and Chancellor of the Exchequer.
